Refenda Vet Bolus

(Fenbendazole BP 250 mg)

Composition: Each Bolus contains Fenbendazole BP 250 mg. .

Indication: Refenda Bolus is a broad-spectrum anthelmintic, which is indicated for the treatment of round worm, lung worm & tape worm of sheep, goat, calf, cattle & buffalo; round worm of horse and round worm & tape worm of dog & cat.

Dosage & Administration:

Sheep and Goat: 1 Bolus (5 mg/kg body weight) as a single dose.

Cattle and Horse: 7.5 mg/kg body weight as a single dose.

Dog and Cat: 20 mg/kg body weight once daily for 5 days. Repeat after every 3-4 months. Or, as prescribed by the registered veterinary doctor.

Contra-Indication: Refenda Bolus should not be used within 14 days of liver fluke treatment and animal less than 3 month of age.

Side Effects: Allergic reaction may be seen in cattle with heavy lung worm infection.

Precaution: Fenbendazole is not embryo toxic. However, risk benefit ration should be considered during administration in pregnant animal. Sufficient drinking water should be given during treatment of the animal.

Withdrawal time:

Meat: 14 days, Milk: 3 days

Storage: Protect from light, store in a cool & dry place and keep out of reach of children.

Presentation: Each box contains 3 X 10 Bolus in blister Strips.
